

N.A.O.M.I. House Needs Your Help!



We need your help to assist us with this vital mission. Currently, N.A.O.M.I. House (<http://naomi.gracenet.org/>) has well water that is **contaminated with arsenic** and unhealthy minerals. They are being forced to drink bottled or hauled water from city or commercial sources. Their current water system is inoperable and needs replacing and is ruining their existing plumbing. Wings of Faith is working to supply a temporary system at N.A.O.M.I. house to use for drinking and cooking, but a **permanent solution would require an additional \$15-25,000.**

Today, around 25-30 persons live at the complex including children from 18 months to 17 years. Native American Outreach Ministries Inc. was established in 1993, and moved into their current children's home in January of 1995 in Joseph City, AZ, right off the 1-40 east of Winslow, Arizona. Native American children suffer from abuse at one of the most alarming rates in our country. Child sexual abuse in Native America is both epidemic and holocaustic. Ninety percent of the children that come to live at Naomi House are the victims of child molestation.

We are told that it takes a village to raise a child. However, when a child has been abused and wounded, it takes more than just one village ... it takes many. N.A.O.M.I. is one small village, working with many others to help hurt children recover from child abuse. The reason N.A.O.M.I. exists is to share the healing love of Jesus Christ with hurting children that desperately need His healing touch.

Can you help us keep them operating? Wings of Faith has been a major partner with N.A.O.M.I. since it opened. Dozens of children have been blessed during the eighteen years of this ministry with the love of our Lord. We want to keep this ministry in operation as a blessing to the victims of abuse and neglect!
