



Dennis Kuhl begins his 12th year with the Angels after joining the club on Nov. 10, 2003. He was initially appointed as the Angels' seventh president before being promoted to Club Chairman on Nov. 14, 2009. Kuhl's central focus is on a renewed effort in the area of civic affairs and community outreach. Kuhl also oversees the Angels' flagship radio station KLAA AM830.

Under his leadership, the Angels have shown tremendous growth and advancement in key business initiatives, including sponsorship and marketing revenues, nationwide expansion and marketing of the Angels brand. Kuhl also played a key role in working with Major League Baseball in the Angels hosting the 2010 All-Star Game.

Last Week's Program: Tom Leedom from "Wings of Faith"



Tom Leedom, President of Wings of Faith Ministries, Inc., has been flying for 47 years. Before he joined Wings of Faith he worked in the medical field representing prosthesis manufacturers. From the Corona Airport 14+ pilot volunteers make 80 flights per year serve Native American Indians in Nevada, Arizona, and New Mexico. They are opening a hub in the 4-corners area for a hangar and warehouse which should be completed in about 2 weeks.

The fourteen tribes on the 27 reservations in these areas have great challenges. They are remote, accessible only by dirt roads. This situation does not attract industry.

abuse, as well as many orphans, create a recipe for disaster. "They are the poor of the poor," said Tom Leedom.

In addition, many wells are contaminated from ancient mining operations.

Wings of Faith has built churches, dug water wells, supplied food, blankets and teaching materials (though the US government gives teachers support).

Wings of Faith operates globally, as ⁽ well as through-out the United States. Tom joined the organization as a volunteer pilot in 2007 and soon after was appointed to the Board. He was elected President in 2015.
